## Regalia Set (Gown, Hood, Cap & Tassel)

All participating students are required to purchase and wear regalia for the SHRS Graduation ceremony on Saturday, May 3, 2025, and the University Undergraduate Commencement on Sunday, May 4, 2025. You can order your regalia from the University Store before or during Graduation Central. Find detailed information and link below.

# Shop Regalia

You can pre-order your regalia starting on Saturday, March 1.

- ➤ If you want to be able to pick up your regalia at Graduation Central, you will need to place your **preorder by Friday**, **April 4**.
- You can also purchase your regalia at Graduation Central.
- Customer Information Needed: You will be asked for your height, weight and degree selection once you add your item to your cart.
- > <u>Shipping:</u> If you choose to have your regalia shipped, you will pay an additional shipping cost of \$17.95.

# Bachelor's Degree Recipients: Regalia cost is \$61.

## Master's Degree Recipients: Regalia cost is \$66.



- Click this box if you will receive a Master's Degree. For the Master of Science Degree
  Specialization choose Master of Science Science Yellow.
- For the Master of Arts Degree Specialization choose Master of Arts White. (This is for Speech-Language Pathology degree recipients only.)

# Doctoral Degree Recipients: Regalia cost is \$80. (Note: When ordering, please keep in mind that a six-sided Tam is not required for your cap.)



- For Clinical Doctorate in OT and Doctor of Medical Science/Physician Assistant Studies, choose for Degree Specialization Clinical Science Science Yellow
- For Doctor of Audiology, choose for Degree Specialization Spruce (Dark Green)
- For Doctor of OT & PT, choose for Degree Specialization Teal
- For PhD choose for Degree Specialization Philosophy (PhD All Areas Royal)

# **Honors Cords for Undergraduates**

To qualify for honors, you must have completed **60** <u>letter-graded</u> <u>credits</u> of coursework from Pitt and have a **3.250** Cumulative GPA.

- 2025 graduates, this will be based on your December 2024 cumulative GPA, as your grades are not final for spring term until *after* the graduation ceremony.
- Pitt honors cords are blue and gold and are the same for all honors designations. Final honors designations for Cum Laude 3.250-3.499, Magna Cum 3.500-3.749 and Summa Cum Laude 3.750-4.000 are determined *after* your degree is certified.

- ONLY doctoral students (including PhDs) will be hooded on stage.
- All students should wear their tassels on the right side of their mortarboard.
- We will **not** have extra regalia or components of regalia for you at the ceremony. Please come prepared!
- Please wear sensible shoes as you must go up and down steps to access and cross the stage.

#### **Hooding for Graduate Students**

Students receiving doctoral degrees in PT, OT (OTD and CScD), Audiology, Physician Assistant Studies or Medica Science will be hooded on stage by their department.

PhD recipients will be hooded on stage by their committee chair and the title of their dissertation will be read while they are on the stage.

Students should carry the hood on their left arm as they approach the stage for hooding.
